The Debtors in these cases are Sea Containers Caribbean Inc., Sea Containers Ltd. ("SCL") and Sea Containers Services Ltd. ("SCSL") (the "Debtors").

of Article VIII, Section F of the Debtors' Second Amended Joint Plan pursuant to Chapter 11, as

amended from time to time.

2. The Claim is deemed timely filed as an unsecured, nonpriority claim.

3. The Debtors and the Committees reserve all rights to object to the Claim on any

grounds other than the grounds that the Claim was filed beyond the applicable bar date.

4. The Debtors and the Committees do not concede any factual allegations contained

in the Motion, and reserve all rights to object to, deny and otherwise contest any factual

allegations contained in the Motion, including but not necessarily limited to any allegation or

suggestion that the Sea Containers 1990 Pension Scheme, the trustees of the Sea Containers 1990

Pension Scheme or any of the Debtors intentionally delayed and/or conspired to intentionally

delay the actuarial certification of the Deficiency Claim (as defined in the Motion).

5. Heysham withdraws with prejudice any claim of priority or administrative

expense status with respect to the Claim.

6. The Motion is denied except as specifically set forth herein.
