**AGREED ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF
HEYSHAM PORT LIMITED TO ALLOW LATE-FILED CLAIM**

This matter is brought before the Court on the Motion Of Heysham Port Limited To Allow Late-Filed Claim (the “Motion”), in which Heysham Port Limited (“Heysham”) seeks allowance of Proof of Claim No. 172 (the “Claim”). In lieu of objecting to the Motion and in order to resolve the instant matter in a consensual manner, the Debtors, the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of SCL (the “SCL Committee”), the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of SCSL (the “SCSL Committee” and together the SCL Committee, the “Committees”) and Heysham agree and stipulate to the terms of this Order. Therefore, it is hereby adjudged, ordered and decreed as follows:

1. The Debtors and the Committees shall not object to the Claim on the grounds that it was filed after the applicable bar date, and waive any rights to object to the Claim on such grounds. The Claim shall not be deemed disallowed or expunged as a result of the last sentence

of Article VIII, Section F of the Debtors' Second Amended Joint Plan pursuant to Chapter 11, as amended from time to time.

2. The Claim is deemed timely filed as an unsecured, nonpriority claim.
3. The Debtors and the Committees reserve all rights to object to the Claim on any grounds other than the grounds that the Claim was filed beyond the applicable bar date.
4. The Debtors and the Committees do not concede any factual allegations contained in the Motion, and reserve all rights to object to, deny and otherwise contest any factual allegations contained in the Motion, including but not necessarily limited to any allegation or suggestion that the Sea Containers 1990 Pension Scheme, the trustees of the Sea Containers 1990 Pension Scheme or any of the Debtors intentionally delayed and/or conspired to intentionally delay the actuarial certification of the Deficiency Claim (as defined in the Motion).
5. Heysham withdraws with prejudice any claim of priority or administrative expense status with respect to the Claim.
6. The Motion is denied except as specifically set forth herein.
