FEE AUDITOR'S FINAL REPORT REGARDING INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF MORRIS, NICHOLS, ARSHT & TUNNELL LLP FOR THE SEVENTH INTERIM PERIOD

This is the final report of Warren H. Smith & Associates, P.C., acting in its capacity as fee auditor in the above-captioned bankruptcy proceedings, regarding the <u>Fee Application of Morris</u>, <u>Nichols</u>, <u>Arsht & Tunnell LLP for the Seventh Interim Period</u> (the "Application").

BACKGROUND

- 1. Morris, Nichols, Arsht & Tunnell LLP ("MNAT") was retained as counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors. In the Application, MNAT seeks approval of fees totaling \$111,610.50 and costs totaling \$8,987.23 for its services from April 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008 (the "Application Period").
- 2. In conducting this audit and reaching the conclusions and recommendations contained herein, we reviewed in detail the Application in its entirety, including each of the time and expense entries included in the exhibits to the Application, for compliance with Local Rule 2016-2 of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, Amended Effective February 1, 2008, and the United States Trustee Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. 330, Issued January 30, 1996 (the "Guidelines"), as well as for consistency with precedent established in the United States

Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, and the Third Circuit Court of Appeals. We served on MNAT an initial report based on our review, and received a response from MNAT, portions of which response are quoted herein.

DISCUSSION

3. We noted that professionals Tate and Urban (each at the rate of \$120 per hour) spent 6.10 hours and \$732.00 performing similar, if not the same, tasks on the same day. The time entries are as follows:

We asked MNAT to please provide further explanation regarding this charge and it responded as follows:

This entry was for a meal at Domaine Hudson in Wilmington, Delaware in connection with the hearing regarding approval of the settlement with the UK pension schemes. MNAT agrees to the fee auditor's recommendation of \$55 per person per dinner and therefore agrees to a reduction of \$27.57 per person totaling, \$192.99.

We appreciate MNAT's response and thus, recommend a reduction of \$192.99 in expenses.

CONCLUSION

5. Thus we recommend approval of fees totaling \$111,244.50 (\$111,610.50 minus \$366.00) and expenses in the amount of \$8,794.24 (\$8,987.23 minus \$192.99) for MNAT's services from April 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008.
