

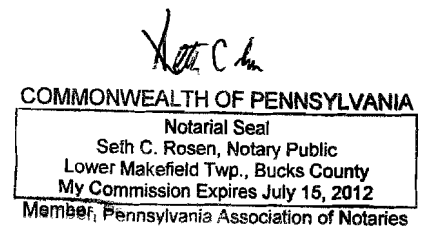

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

their vessel was attacked. During the height of the drama on the high seas, more than 29 pirate boats surrounded passenger (cruise) *Athena* (16144 gt, built 1948) off the coast of Somalia. Almost 200 Australian women and 189 men are on board the vessel, which is cruising through the Gulf of Aden. The pirates made at least three attempts to board and take control of the vessel. "We looked outside and saw 29 small boats with up to six pirates in each boat," one of the passengers said. "We have now seen an air force Orion circling the convoy. This seemed to scare off the pirates." The passengers said the vessel's master had earlier confirmed crew members had used water cannons during the night to stop pirates from boarding as the vessel passed through the high-risk area of the exit of the Gulf of Aden. "The captain did state an oil tanker to the rear of us was attacked," the passenger said. The Department of Foreign Affairs confirmed the incident last night. *Athena* was due to dock in Fremantle on Monday (Dec 8). It is currently heading to the Seychelles. World Cruises Agency operations director Carlos Acosta played down the incident,

talks look to be nearing a conclusion, a Somali official said today. Aweys Ali Said, chairman of Somalia's Galkayo town, said negotiations to free the vessel was going well. "The pirates have regained hope of getting a ransom. Ukrainian and Somali men from abroad are involved in the bargaining," he said by telephone. "I'm sure America is also playing a role because the warship has moved some kilometres (miles) further away." The US Navy sent a destroyer and other vessels to track the *Faina* after it was seized by Somali gunmen in September. Lieutenant Nathan Christensen, a spokesman for the US Fifth Fleet based in Bahrain, said several US vessels remained within sight of the cargo ship -- which is carrying 33 Soviet-era T-72 tanks and other heavy weapons. A business associate of the

liament (Majlis) member, Parviz Sarvari, said Iran may consider military option against the pirates in the Gulf of Aden, Iran's satellite Press TV reported Tuesday (Dec 2). Sarvari, as the member of Iranian parliament's National Security and Foreign Policy Commission, stressed that: "Iran considers a diplomatic solution to the issue reached through international cooperation the better option," adding that "however, the military approach is among the options that Iran's National Security Commission is mulling over." Earlier in November, Somalia pirates hijacked bulk carrier *Delight*, which was chartered by an Iranian company. They took its 25 crew as hostage. The vessel, loaded with 36,000 tons of wheat, was bound for Iran's Bandar Abbas Port when it was hijacked. (See issue of Nov 26.)

## Seizures & Arrests

### ARAL WIND (Liberia)

Lagos, Dec 3 -- A Federal High Court, sitting in Lagos, has given an order for the arrest and detention of product tanker *Aral Wind* (10985 gt, built 1988) at Apapa Port and Quays. The order was made to ensure the payment of damages on the balance of petroleum products imported into the country by Jag Global resources, which was wrongfully detained by the owners of the vessel. Justice Mohammed Liman, who gave the order, held that the vessel should be detained pending provision of an acceptable bank guarantee to be issued by First Bank Plc, Union Bank Plc, Zenith Bank Plc and or United Bank for Africa Plc. According to the applicant, the act of *Aral Wind* in detaining its petroleum products cargo had occasioned untold

losses in excess of \$10m, including interests on loans to banks and loss of value for the product. The applicant had asked the court to compel the ship owners to pay it damages and interest at the rate of 21% annum from Nov 6, 2008, until judgement, and payment sought an order of the court to arrest and detain the vessel until the debt was paid. The applicant had alleged that the foreign owners of the vessel had rebuffed all entreaties from the Nigerian company and had detained the product for over four months. In the warrant of arrest issued by the judge in the name of President Umaru Yar'Adua, noted that the cargo was carried offshore Cotonou, Benin Republic, pursuant to a charter party agreement between the applicant and *Aral Wind*.

Iraq has the world's third-largest proven oil reserves, at 115bn barrels. It pumped about 2.3m barrels a day in October, down slightly from this summer's 2.5m b/d, which was the highest level since the US-led invasion in 2003, according to the International Energy Agency.

Investment in the oil sector has been hindered by disagreements over the proposed new hydrocarbons law, which would outline foreign participation in the oil and gas industries and how to share the revenues between Iraq's provinces.

During the 18-month stalemate, the semi-autonomous Kurdistan regional government has enacted its own hydrocarbons law and has

However, the Tawke field, operated by Norway's Det Norske Oljeselskap (DNO), and Taq Taq, a joint venture between Turkey's Genel Enerji and Swiss-Canadian Addax Petroleum, were cleared for export before Kurdistan introduced its law.

Analysts say that an agreement covering only the early contracts would be implicitly admitting that the later contracts were illegal, and the Kurds might have to give up some or all of the exploration contracts agreed with companies including Austria's OMV, MOL of Hungary, and India's Heritage.

That would be a high price for Kurdistan to pay, ana-

lyzed it to expect exports from the Tawke oil field to begin during the first quarter of next year, although warning that it had yet to receive proper authorisation.

Linking Tawke to the northern pipeline could help Iraq sustain oil flows because the field is far from the area where the pipeline is frequently attacked by the Kurdish PKK rebel group.

Although Turkey would in principle buy or export Kurdish oil and gas, it will not do so without Baghdad's authorisation.

The two fields would probably produce about 60,000b/d each, but analysts estimate that their combined output could reach 250,000b/d by the end of next year.
