As to this account, claimant claims base tax in the amount of \$28.32, plus statutory monthly interest and penalties at the rate of 20% per annum accounting from February 1, 2010 for aggregate interest and penalties to the petition date, September 21, 2010, in the amount of \$3.78 for an aggregate prepetition claim in the amount of \$32.10. 
