

**ADDENDUM TO PROOF OF CLAIM OF
CANTERBURY PROPERTIES, LLC**

Canterbury Properties, LTD (“Canterbury”) hereby asserts a claim (the “Claim”) against Large Apparel of Illinois, Inc., Case No. 10-B-13017 (the “Debtor) in an amount not less than \$48,625.79 for (i) unpaid rents due at the time of the Debtor’s bankruptcy filing under the Lease (the “Lease”) between Canterbury and the Debtor, and (ii) damages should the Lease be rejected.

As of the date of this Claim, the Debtor has indicated their intention to assume the Lease and pay a negotiated cure claim amount. As this Court has not yet approved the assumption of the Lease, nor has the Debtor signed the agreement regarding the agreed upon cure claim, Canterbury files this Claim at of an abundance of caution to maintain its rights to assert a pre-petition claim, and a Lease Rejection Claim. To the extent that the Lease is assumed and the negotiated cure claim is paid in full, Canterbury will withdraw their claim accordingly.


