**ADDENDUM TO PROOF OF CLAIM OF  
JEFFREY PLAZA INVESTORS, LLC**

Jeffrey Plaza Investors, LLC (“Jeffrey”) hereby asserts a claim (the “Claim”) against Large Apparel of Illinois, Inc., Case No. 10-B-13017 and Urban Brands, Inc., Case No. 10-B-13005 (the “Debtors”) in an amount not less than \$28,888.78 for unpaid rents due at the time of the Debtors bankruptcy filings under the Lease (the “Lease”) between Jeffrey and the Debtors. In addition, should the Lease be rejected, Jeffrey is entitled to rejection damages in the amount of approximately \$127,562.16. Thus, in the event the Lease is rejected, Jeffrey is entitled to a general unsecured claim in the approximate amount of \$156,450.94.

**Jeffrey’s Pre-Petition Claim**

1. Pursuant to the Lease, in addition to rent (the “Rent”), the Debtors were to pay their proportionate share of, among other things, sales and use taxes, real estate taxes and assessments, and common operating costs throughout the Term (collectively, the “Additional Obligations”).

2. As of the Petition Date, Jeffrey was owed \$28,888.78 for Rent and Additional Obligations (the “Pre-Petition Claim”).

**Jeffrey’s Rejection Damages Claim**

3. In the event the Lease is rejected, Jeffrey is entitled to rejection damages, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(b)(6), “for the greater of one year, or 15 percent, not to exceed three years, of the remaining term of such lease [from] . . . the date of the filing of the petition . . . .”

4. Currently, monthly rent and cam charges total approximately \$10,630.18.

5. Thus, should the Lease be rejected, Jeffrey is entitled to rejection damages, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 365(d) and (g) and 502(b) and (g), in the approximate amount of \$127,562.16 [calculated as 12 times \$10,630.18].

6. Jeffrey hereby reserves the right to amend this Claim to include: (i) any additional claims for rejection damages; or (b) any additional amounts due under the Lease to the extent that Jeffrey determines such amounts exist.

7. To the extent that the Lease is assumed and the Pre-Petition Claim is paid in full, Jeffrey will withdraw their claim accordingly.


