**AFFIDAVIT OF GWENDOLYN SCOTT-ADAMS IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR
RELIEF FROM STAY**

Gwendolyn Scott-Adams, deposes and says:

1. I am a former employee of Urban Brands, Inc. and the plaintiff in an action against that company currently pending in federal district court for the Southern District of New York, Case No. 07-Civ. 746 (DCF). I submit this affidavit in support of this motion for relief from the automatic stay of that case so that I may continue with the proceedings in the New York federal court. If I prevail in that action, I will not seek to collect on any judgment other than through Urban Brands' current chapter 11 cases.

2. I filed my federal law suit *pro se* in June 2007. In October 2009, after obtaining an attorney, I filed an amended complaint, a copy of which is attached to this motion. The complaint alleges that Urban Brands (1) failed to pay me premium overtime pay in violation of the federal Fair Labor Standards Act and New York State Labor Law, (2) fired me on the basis of race/national origin in violation of the Civil Rights Act of 1866, and (3) denied me reasonable accommodation for a disability in violation of the New York City and New York State Human Rights Laws. Discovery in the case has been completed. The district court had scheduled dates for a summary judgment motion when the stay took effect.

3. A trial of my case in Delaware rather than New York would be a hardship to me for both medical and financial reasons.


4. I suffer from severe arthritis in both knees and have been informed that this condition is likely to continue indefinitely. The arthritis causes me significant pain. At times I need to walk with a cane.

5. In the fall of 2010 I had surgery to correct a torn meniscus in my left knee. I am now undergoing physical therapy, which will continue for an indefinite period of time. In addition, recovery from surgery has strained my right knee, as a result of which I may now need surgery to replace my right knee.


6. Traveling to Delaware for trial would cause me significant pain and interfere with my rehabilitation program.

7. In addition, the cost of traveling to and staying in Delaware for a trial would be a serious financial hardship for me. I recently lost my home and I need to save money for a new place to live.

8. I therefore respectfully request that this Court lift the stay of my case in the New York federal district court.
